

# Importing Publication Citations from ORCID into Interfolio

## Instructions for Faculty

Citations can be imported directly from your ORCID account into your Interfolio Faculty180 activities. Interfolio takes care of moving the elements of each citation into the appropriate field (author, title, journal, etc.), and flags possible duplicate entries for your attention. You can adjust each citation as necessary, and upload a copy of the publication.

### PART 1 - Log on to Interfolio

There are two ways to log on to Interfolio

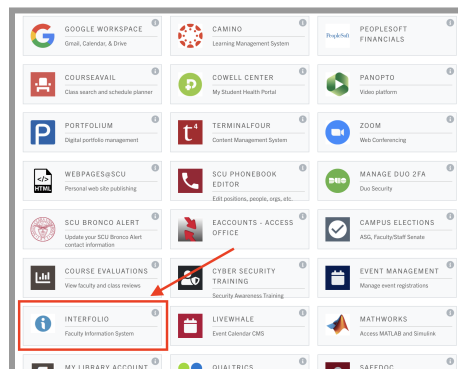
#### 1. Interfolio: <https://www.scu.edu/interfolio>

Click the Partner Institution button.

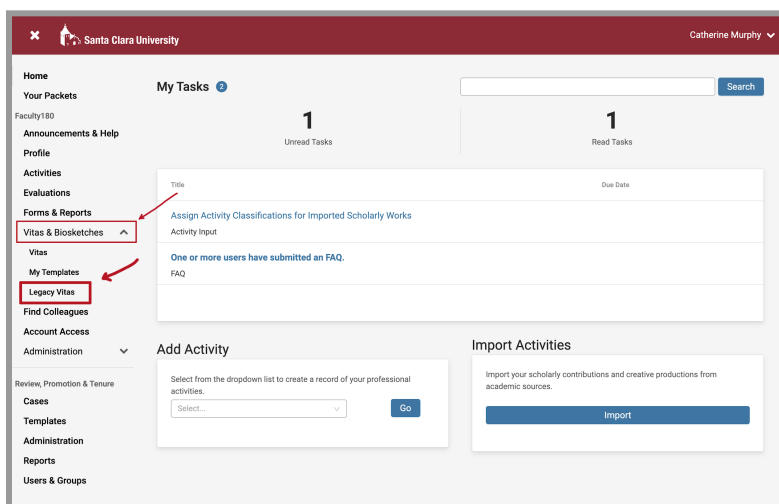
Search for "Santa Clara University" and click the Sign In button.

Log in with your single sign-on credentials.

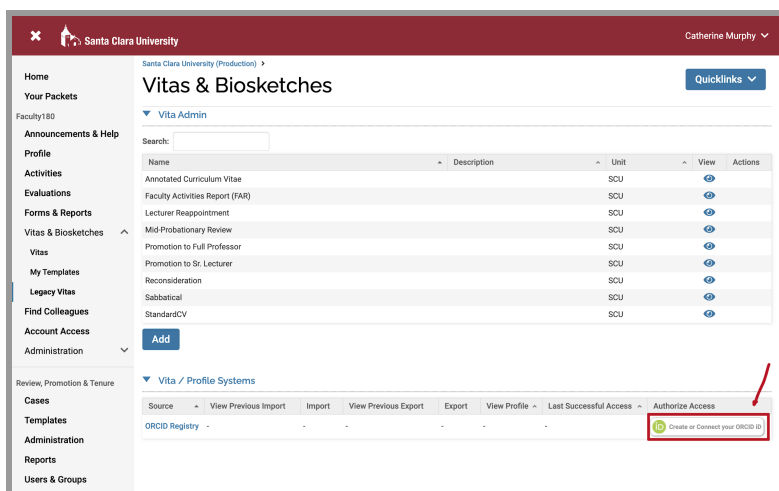
#### 2. Click on the Interfolio tile on your MySCU SSO page.



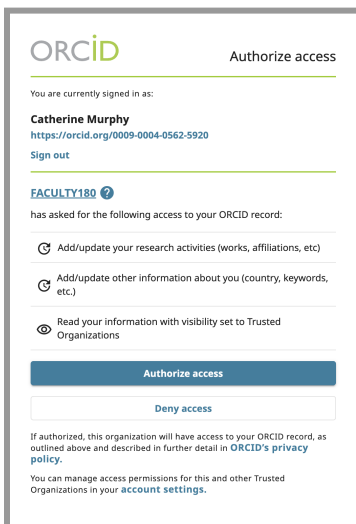
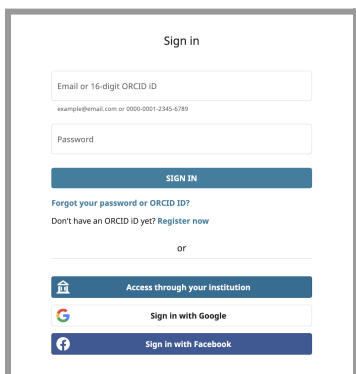
## PART 2 - Import Your Publication Citations



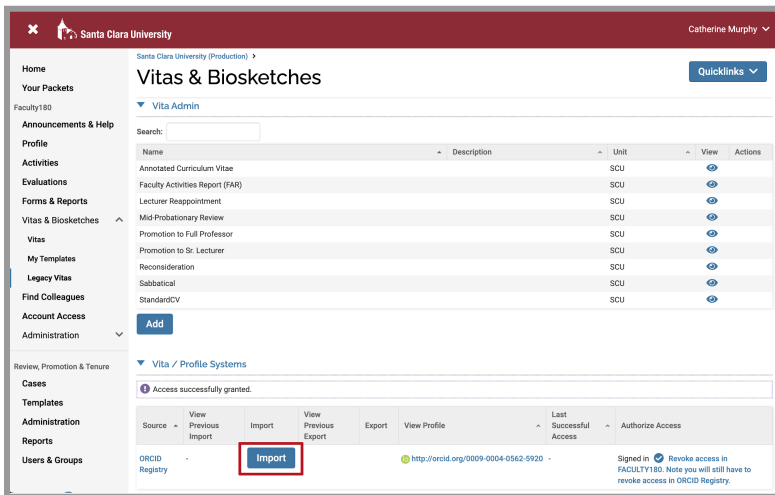
1. Open “Vitas & Biosketches” and select “Legacy Vitas”



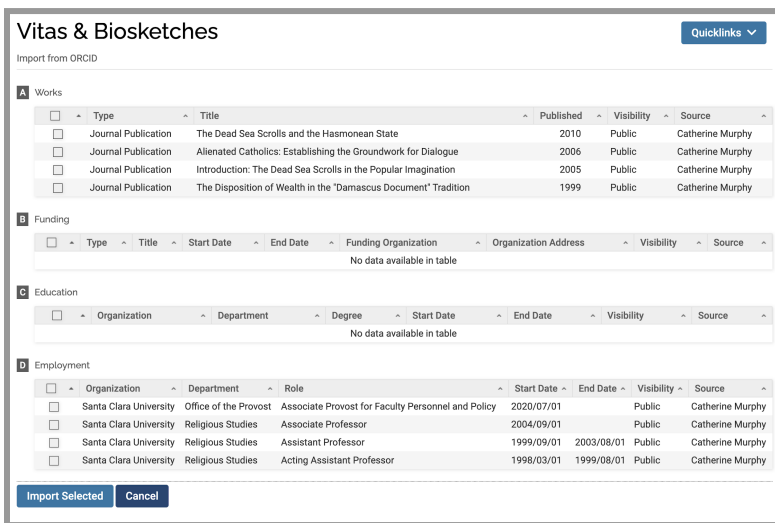
2. Select the “Create or Connect your ORCID ID” button in the bottom right corner



3. Sign in to your ORCID account and authorize your Faculty180 account to access it
  - a. Sign in with your email or 16-digit ORCID iD and your ORCID password, and click the **Sign In** button.
  - b. In the pop-up window, click the **Authorize access** button so that Faculty180 can connect with your ORCID account.

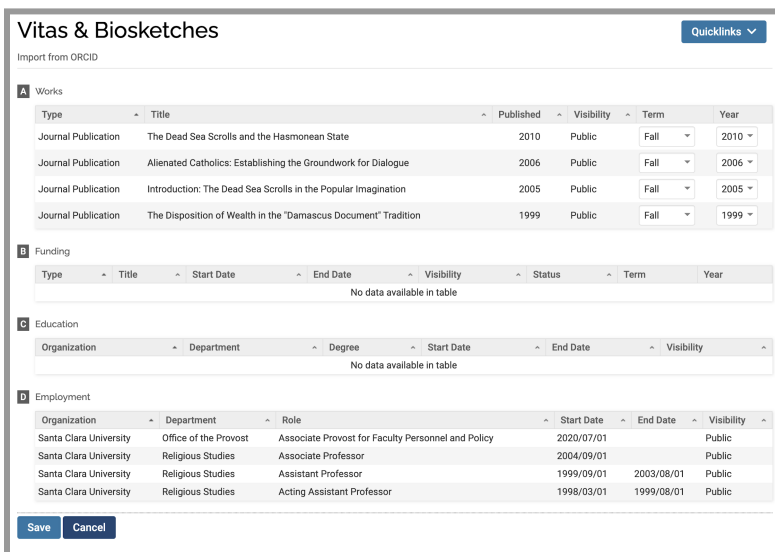


4. Back on the Legacy Vitas page, in the ORCID Registry area, click the **Import** button



5. Select the elements of your ORCID profile that you would like to import, and click **Import Selected**

You may have information in ORCID not only in your "Works," but also in Funding, Education, and Employment history. Select all that you would like to import by clicking the box to the left of the entry.



6. Confirm the Term and Year for each publication

a. Imported publications likely have the correct year, but the default "Fall" term. Correct the term (you can also edit each publication later in the "Scholarly Contributions and Creative Productions" activity category).

b. Click **Save**.



