**Day 1: Wednesday, June 16, 2027 Overnight Flight** Set out to explore Scandinavia by land and experience one of the world's most incredible regions.

**Day 2: Thursday, June 17, 2027 Stockholm, Sweden** Arrive in the beautiful city of Stockholm. With no scheduled activities during the day, take some time to venture out on your own and get to know this relatively compact city, built on 14 islands and connected by 57 bridges. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers for dinner. (D)

**Day 3: Friday, June 18, 2027 Stockholm** Join a local expert to see Stockholm's greatest vistas and attractions, including Gamla Stan (Old Town), Riddarholm Church, the Royal Palace, and the Parliament, on a historic and cultural walking tour. Enjoy a visit inside Stockholm's stunning City Hall, which displays towering brick walls paired with an opulent interior. Explore the Vasa Ship Museum and learn about the vessel's shocking maiden voyage, when it sank in a single nautical mile (the perfectly preserved ship, commissioned in the 1600s by King Vasa, was raised from the bottom of the harbor 334 years later). This afternoon is yours to explore Stockholm independently. Discover its strikingly colorful architecture and sample its innovative cuisine. (B)

**Day 4: Saturday, June 19, 2027 Stockholm - Gothenburg** Bid farewell to Stockholm and set off by local train for a relaxing journey to Gothenburg. Take some free time for lunch and explore independently before meeting your local guide for a walking city tour. Tonight, why not take an after-dinner stroll through the friendly and laid-back city streets before settling in for the night. (B)

**Day 5: Sunday, June 20, 2027 Gothenburg - Copenhagen, Denmark** This morning, set out into the country to visit Sofiero Palace, once a summer residence of the Swedish royal family. After a guided tour of the castle and included light lunch, continue to Denmark, ending the day in the cosmopolitan city of Copenhagen. (B, L)

**Day 6: Monday, June 21, 2027 Copenhagen** Join a local expert and set off on an engaging three-hour walking tour of Denmark's capital city. See Nyhavn, the picturesque harbor lined with colorful facades and charming cafes, as well as Amalienborg Palace, the residence of the Danish Royal Family. Visit the famous Little Mermaid statue, and finish at Tivoli Gardens, the world's second oldest amusement park. This afternoon is yours to spend how you wish. (B)

**Day 7: Tuesday, June 22, 2027 Copenhagen** Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore Copenhagen your way. (B)

**Day 8: Wednesday, June 23, 2027 Copenhagen - Oslo, Norway** This morning, **it's your choice!** Visit the National Museum of Denmark for an audio-guided visit at your own pace **-OR-** visit the Home of Carlsberg brewery, where an exhibition takes you through the history of the Jacobsen family and how they built their empire around this iconic beer. This afternoon, head to the airport to catch a short flight to Oslo, Norway. After settling into your hotel, join your fellow travelers for dinner. (B, D)

**Day 9: Thursday, June 24, 2027 Oslo** This morning, join a local guide for an exploration of Oslo. By motorcoach and on foot, discover the rich heritage of this fascinating city. The afternoon is yours to further explore independently. (B)

**Day 10: Friday, June 25, 2027 Oslo - Flåm** Travel north from Norway's capital to the majestic fjord region. Visit Borgund Stave Church, the intricate structure built in dedication to the Apostle Andrew in 1180. Arrive in the quaint village of Flåm, nestled at the entrance to the stunning Aurlandsfjord, and visit the Railway Museum before settling in for the evening. (B, D)

**Day 12: Sunday, June 27, 2027 Loen - Fjord Cruise - Loen** An enchanting day in Norway's fjord region begins. In Geiranger, a UNESCO World Heritage site, embark on an exhilarating Geirangerfjord cruise, soaking in some of Norway's most beautiful

scenery along the way. One of the most famous fjords in the world, Geirangerfjord is where you'll find Norway's mightiest waterfalls: the Seven Sisters, the Bridal Veil, and the Suitor. Marvel at homesteads along the steep sides of the mountains, where farms have been kept for centuries. The day's relaxed pace offers the opportunity to soak up the nature and stunning scenery of the region. (B, D)

**Day 13: Monday, June 28, 2027 Loen - Bergen** Be inspired by Norway's most impressive landscapes en route to Bergen – the gateway to the fjords. A visit to the Sunnfjord Folk Museum tells the story of local enterprise and community spirit. Founded with

### Experience It! Norwegian Fjords

The evolution of the fjords began some three million years ago, when Norway was covered by an ice cap thinner along the coast than inland. With the arrival of a milder climate, the ice began to melt and produce great waterfalls that logged the soil and descended to the sea. Valleys were filled in by the ocean, creating the fjords. **The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3.** This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

**Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).**

There are numerous long touring days, with 8 hours of touring, excluding dinners.

Some of the older properties and attractions in Scandinavia may not have elevators.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Museums may close unexpectedly or for the observance of holidays.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple accommodations are not available.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.
